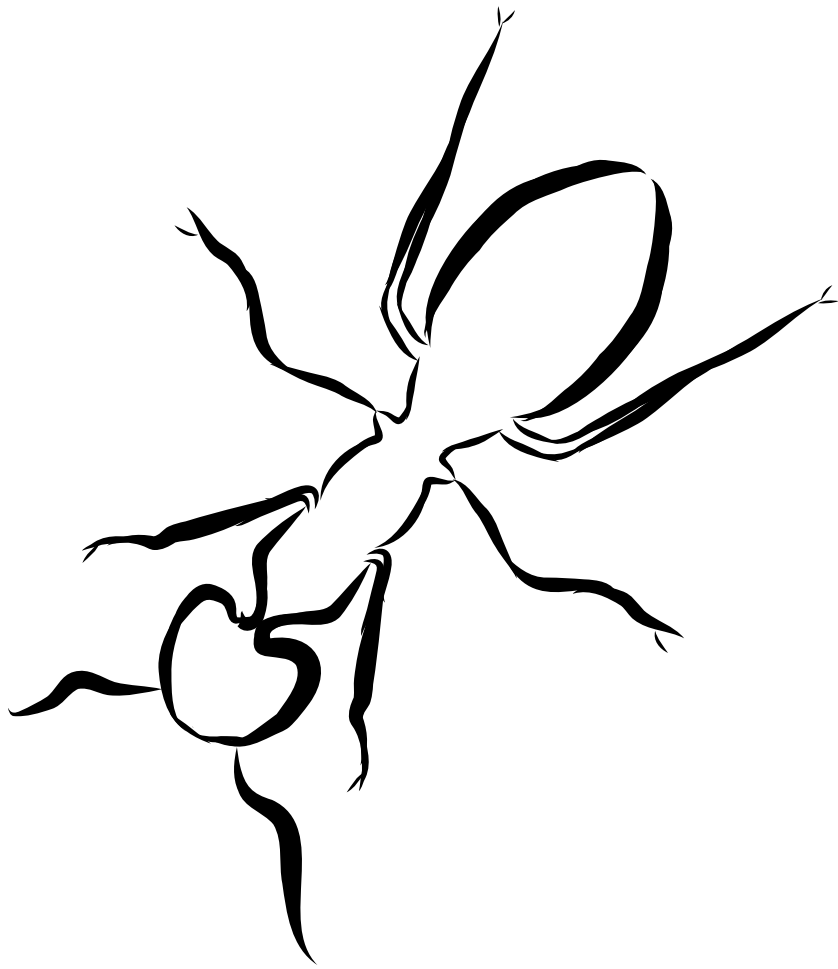

Ants are super strong-they can carry things heavier than their own bodies!

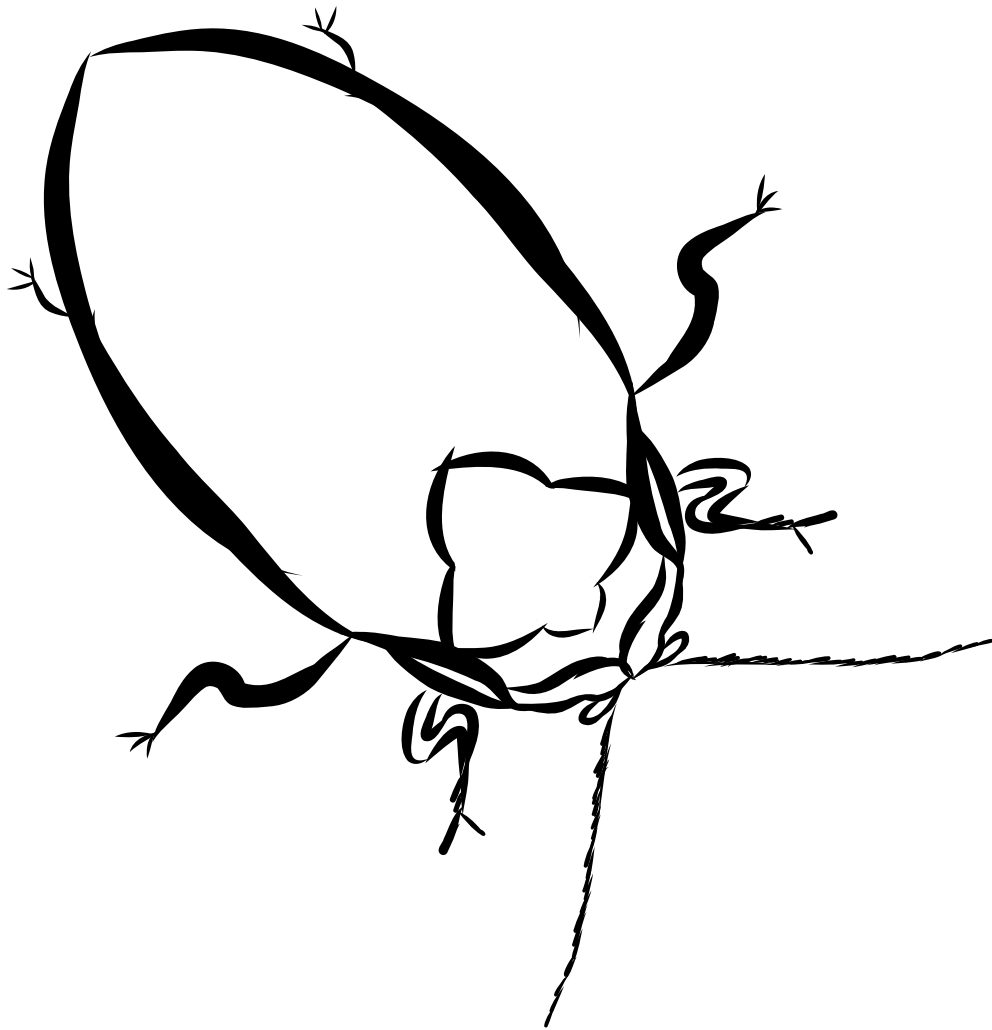

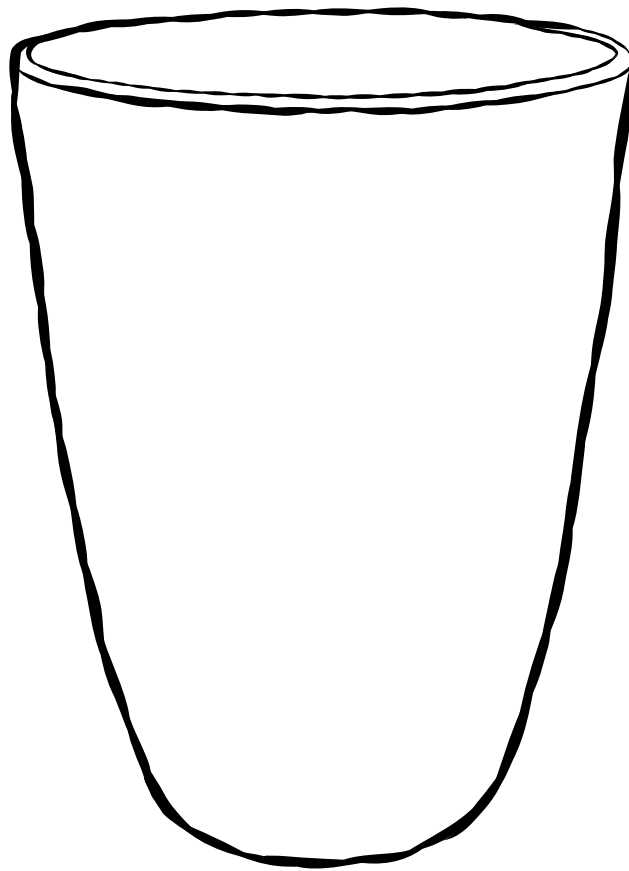

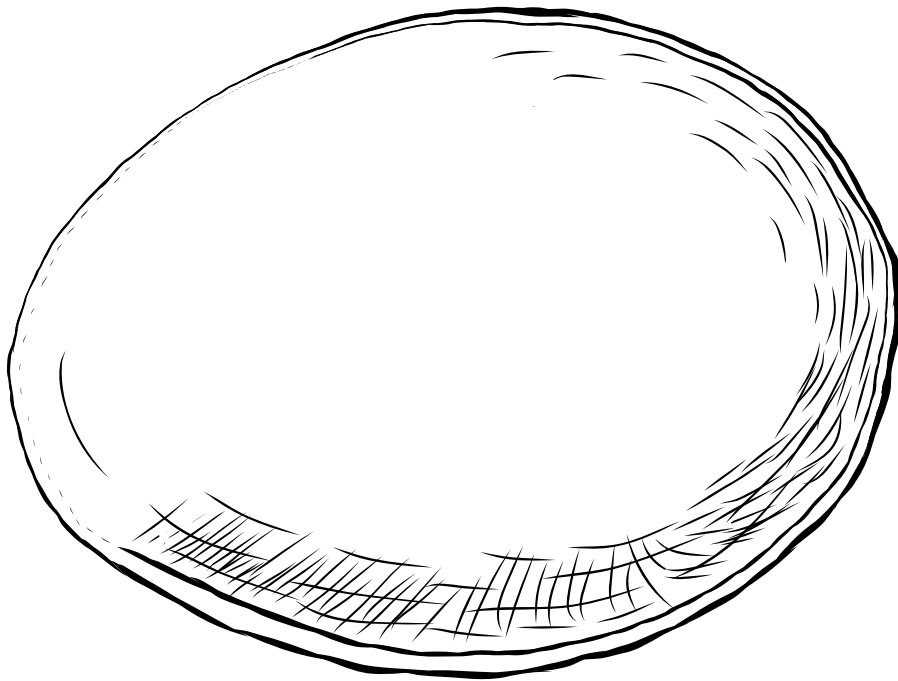

Eggs come from birds, and baby chicks grow inside them like little surprises waiting to hatch.

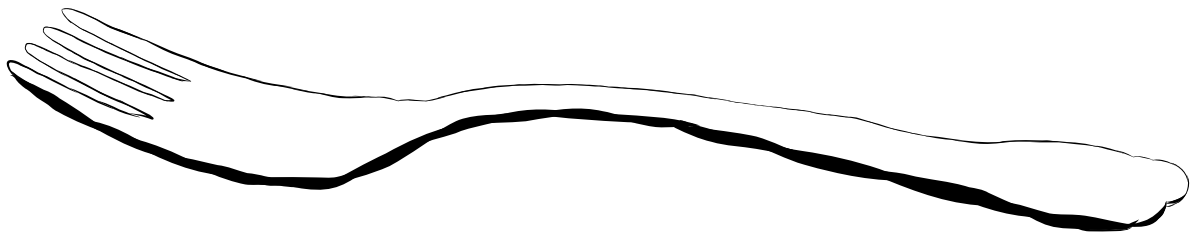
